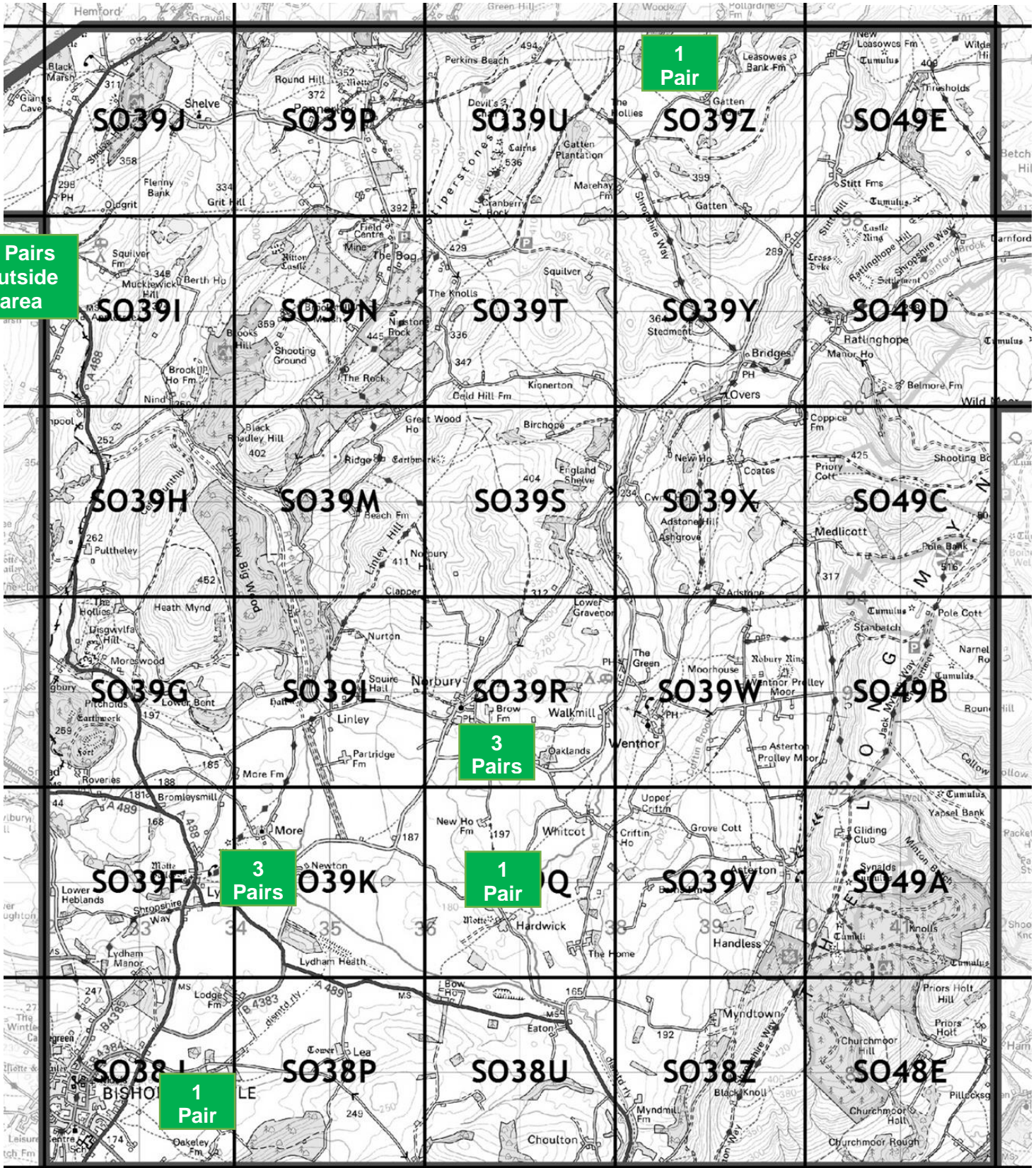


# Upper Onny Wildlife Group Lapwing Records 2017

Records from all surveys and casual records



Only 1 site, with 1 pair, was occupied in the northern half of the area

The three pairs in the west of SO39K were on the HLS “Lapwing Field”. At least two pairs had chicks (one brood of 3 ringed), outcome unknown. Single bird seen in SO39F in mid-April probably from this site

The three pairs near Norbury were reported by Tony Cross, who caught and ringed 10 chicks, of which probably 6 fledged

There were none at Lower Stapeley, probably because it was too dry, and grazed by sheep, but there were three pairs just to the south, and two of these pairs had chicks (outcome unknown). The nest field was outside the area

**Total 9 pairs (c.f. 14 in 2016 and 13 – 17 pairs in 2015, the lowest since UOWG started)**
