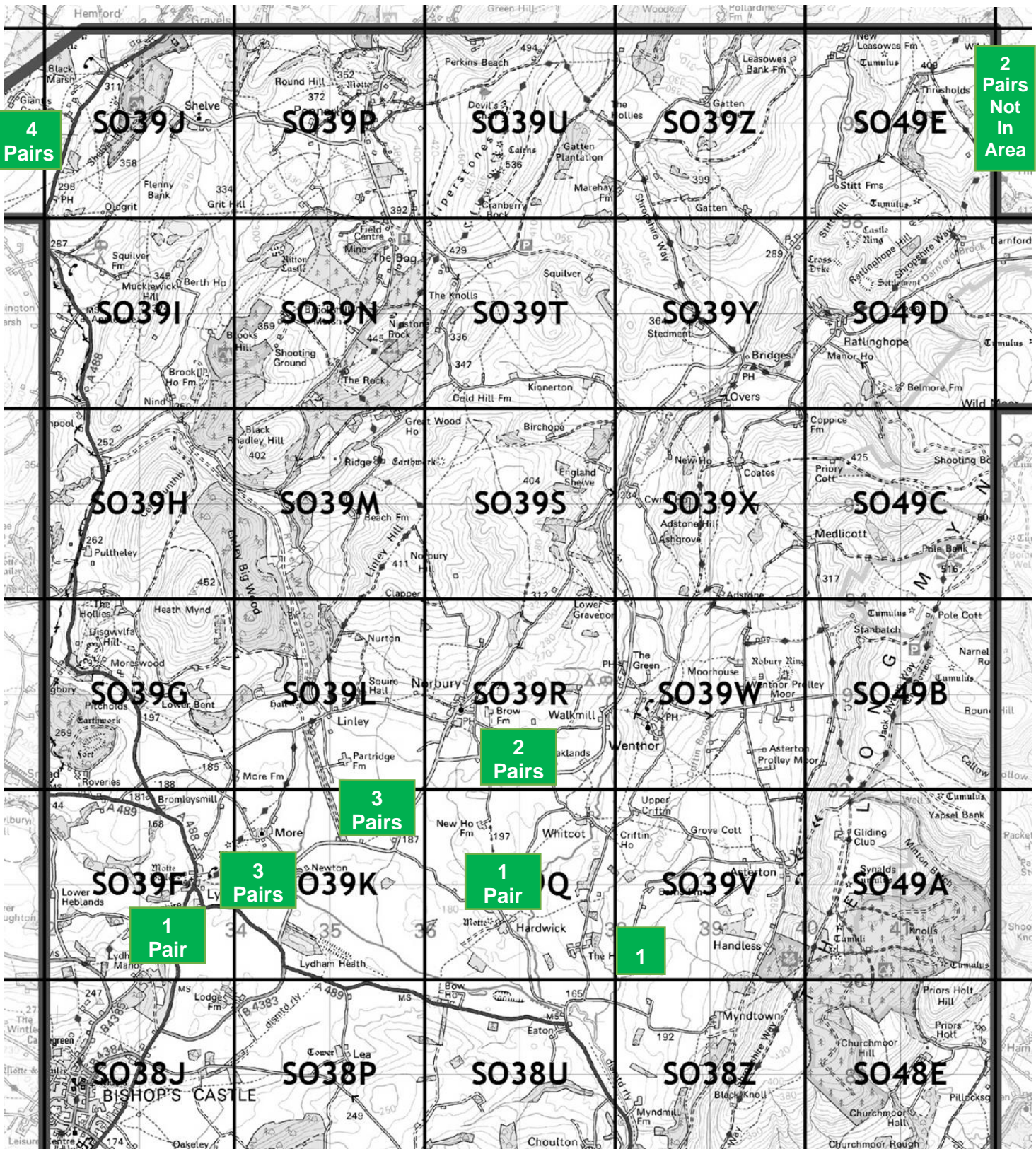


Upper Onny Wildlife Group Lapwing Records 2016

Records from All surveys (March – June 2016)



No pairs have been found in at least one of the four squares SO39T, U, Y or Z for the first time since surveys started in 2004.

The single in flight in SO39V in early April was probably one of the pair nesting near Hardwick

The three pairs in the north-east corner of SO39K all relayed after the fields were ploughed. The three pairs in the west of SO39K were on the HLS “Lapwing Field”.

Chicks at Lower Stapeley (>=2) and at least 2 fledged young at Lydham

Total 14 pairs (c.f. 13 – 17 pairs in 2015) is the lowest since 2006.
