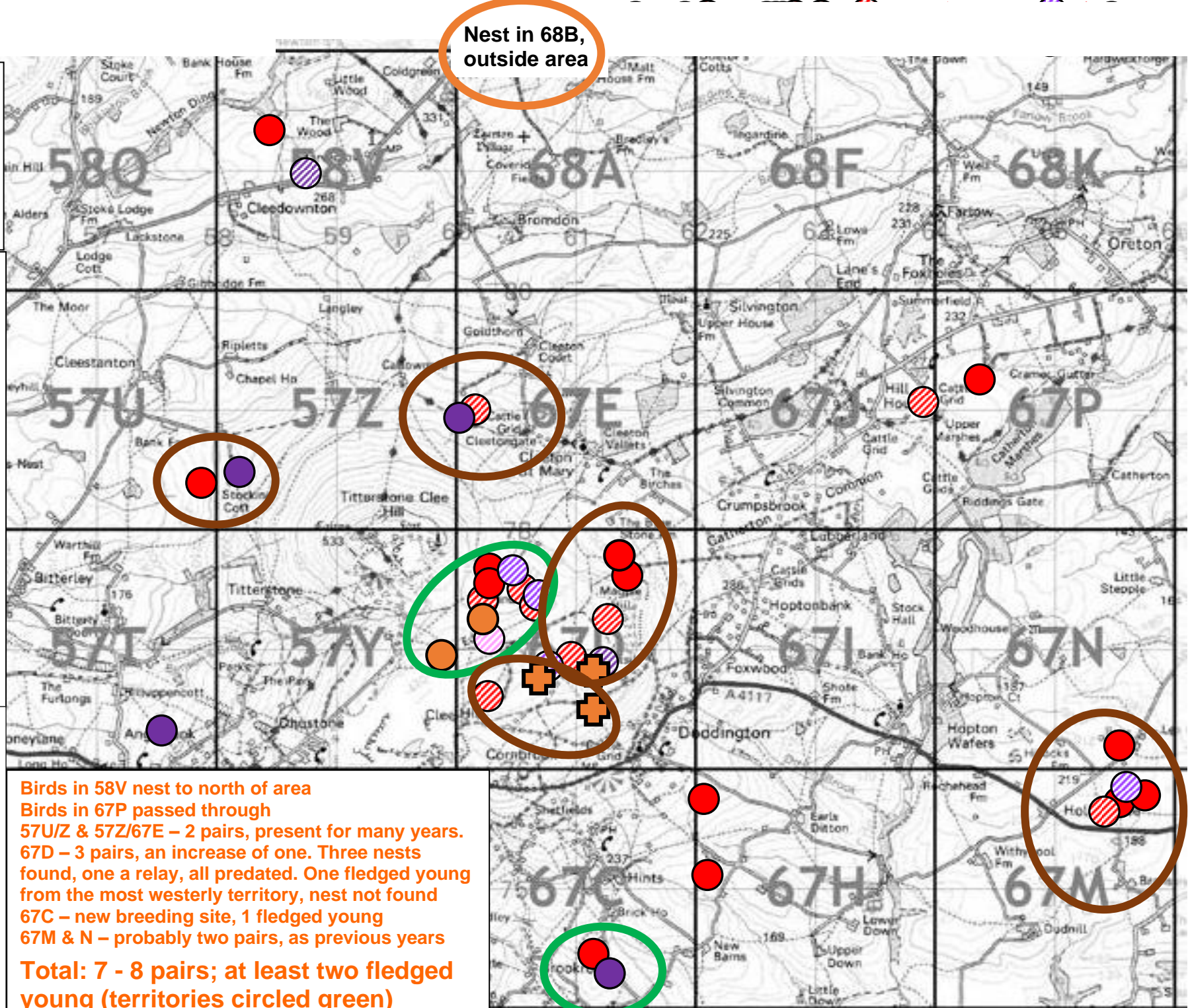
Observations during

Nest in 68B,
outside area

Birds in 58V nest to north of area
Birds in 67P passed through
57U/Z & 57Z/67E – 2 pairs, present for many years.
67D – 3 pairs, an increase of one. Three nests
found, one a relay, all predated. One fledged young
from the most westerly territory, nest not found
67C – new breeding site, 1 fledged young
67M & N – probably two pairs, as previous years
**Total: 7 - 8 pairs; at least two fledged
young (territories circled green)**
